THE MISSION

- Sailors and submariners in Guam are the frontline of the submarine force
- Personnel are forward-deployed, and serve as the first responders regarding undersea warfare in the Pacific
 Apra Harbor in Guam is homeport to USS Chicago (SSN 721), USS Key West (SSN 722), USS Oklahoma City (SSN 723),
- USS Topeka (SSN 754), USS Emory S. Land (AS 39) and USS Frank Cable (AS 40)

♦ A tour of duty in Guam will allow Sailors and submariners to visit countries like Japan, Hong Kong, Saipan, Singapore, Malaysia, Thailand and the Philippines on port visits
